- > The transformation toward a green society needs a cross-sector trade fair marketplace


II. Solution:







EU Regulations/ Company Mandatory Reports

From 2025, all companies in the EU with more than 500 employees will be obliged to submit an annual mandatory report on the status quo of their emissions and the environmental impact of their company to the tax authorities.

From 2028, this will apply to all companies with 10 or more employees (regulations and directives under the European Green Deal, ESG, CSRD, ESRS, SFDR and the EU Taxonomy Regulation).

The main objective of TransformIT Europe is to support the over 25 millions of companies in the EU on their path to climate neutrality in 2050.







A New Role for IT System Houses?

IT system houses have the opportunity to position themselves as ESG consultants.

Companies in all sectors and government clients increasingly need support to achieve their sustainability goals. The systems house is in an interesting position to provide expertise and solutions to support their work. 
